Hotels nearest to Ordnance Survey's HQ

Premier Inn Southampton North

Romsey Road, Southampton, SO16 0XJ

On the A3057, close to the junction of the M27 and M271 and less than 5 miles (8 km) from the very heart of Southampton's city centre, the hotel offers comfortable, great-value rooms and free parking.

The Premier Inn Southampton North has a convenient location with good access to the region's major roads. Southampton train station is 3 miles away and Southampton ferry port is 4 miles away.

The hotel has a 24-hour reception desk and some rooms can take 2 adults and up to 2 children (under 16 years). The 2 children also get a free full breakfast when accompanied by an adult eating a full breakfast.

An all-you-can-eat buffet breakfast is available each morning and includes the expected cooked items such as scrambled, fried, poached or boiled eggs, and pork or vegetarian sausages. There is also a wide continental selection.

The on-site Beefeater restaurant serves freshly cooked char-grilled food.

Holiday Inn Express Southampton West

Adanac Park, Redbridge Lane, Southampton, SO16 0YP

Located off junction 1 of the M271, just off the M27, this hotel has modern rooms and free parking. Guests enjoy a 50% discount on day passes for the local David Lloyd leisure club, and continental breakfast is included in the room rate.

The Holiday Inn Express Southampton is ideal for visiting Southampton city centre, the Cruise Terminal, the Isle of Wight, the New Forest and West Quay shopping centre. Southampton Airport is 7 miles (11.3 km) away.

The refurbished hotel has 2 meeting rooms with natural daylight. All rooms have an en suite power shower, Wi-Fi (at an additional cost) and satellite TV. Accessible rooms are available.

On site, guests can enjoy a 3-course meal, including fresh salad, hot pizzas and tasty curries.

Wi-Fi is free for the first 30 minutes and then a choice of chargeable packages is available.

Hotels within 5 min of the Railway Station

Buses to OS stop near the platform 1 exit. The 1 is a direct bus link from the station to Adanac Park and takes approximately 25 minutes, alighting at the bus stop on Adanac Drive.

ibis Budget Southampton Centre

3 West Quay Road, Southampton, SO15 1RA

With free Wi-Fi on site, this Ibis hotel is situated right in the heart of Southampton. The train station is a few minutes' walk away, and the Medieval City Walls are also close by. There is limited outdoor parking on site.

Rooms at Ibis Budget Southampton Centre are modern and bright, and each benefits from air cooling, a flat-screen TV, and an en suite shower room.

A continental breakfast is served each morning in the cafeteria, with a wide choice of options available.

The Mayflower Theatre is a 10-minute walk away, and the different campuses of Southampton University can be reached in around 10 minutes by car.

Novotel Southampton

1 West Quay Road, Southampton, SO15 1RA

In Southampton's centre, this Novotel looks over the port and is just 400 metres from Southampton Central Rail Station. It has an indoor heated pool and modern rooms with 26-inch LCD TVs.

The spacious rooms at Novotel Southampton feature a private bathroom and a large work area. TVs include pay-per-view movies and internet access. Rooms also include a laptop safe, a hairdryer, and tea/coffee facilities.

The hotel is next to West Quay Retail Park, and less than 15 minutes' walk from Southampton's central shops and 5 adjacent parks.

The Elements Restaurant serves modern food with an outdoor terrace. Elements Bar serves drinks and light meals in stylish surroundings featuring a large-screen TV with Sky Sports channels.

Up to 2 children (under 16 years) can stay free (with breakfast) when sharing a room with adults. This includes access to video games, baby equipment and a healthy children's menu. Families also get late check-out on Sundays (until 17:00).

A bit further afield (up to 1 mile from the Railway Station)

The White Star Tavern (ca 1 mile from the railway station)

28 Oxford Street, Southampton, SO14 3DJ

Located in Southampton city centre, this 5-star boutique inn was built in the 19th century. It is now a contemporary hotel offering free Wi-Fi access.

The White Star Tavern is located on Southampton's cosmopolitan Oxford Street, in the city's historic maritime district. The building was completely renovated in 2007 and mixes original features with modern comforts and style.

Rooms have laptop safes, king-size beds with luxury Egyptian cotton bed linen and minibars stocked with your favourite drinks and snacks. The flat-screen TVs have Freeview digital channels. The modern bathrooms have large showers.

The White Star has received 2 AA Rosettes for the quality of its great-value food. Dishes are made using fresh local produce. The bar serves wines, award-winning ales and cocktails.

This is in my view the nicest hotel (have stayed there before) where those who want can gather for dinner the evening before the conference (19.00, Wednesday 11th September).

Quite close to the White Star Tavern is the following hotel:

Cargo (ca 1 mile from the railway station)
20-22 Oxford Street, Southampton, SO14 3DJ

Located in Southampton's city centre, this boutique hotel serves local food in its modern restaurant and has an on-site bar which specialises in cocktails. Rooms at Cargo have a walk-in power shower in the fully-tiled and stylish private bathroom.

Ocean Village Marina, an entertainment complex, is within 10 minutes' walk of Cargo, as is WestQuay shopping centre. Southampton Central Rail Station is 1 mile away and the New Forest National Park can be reached after a 15-minute drive.

With Egyptian cotton bed linen, each neutrally decorated room also has a flat-screen TV with a DVD player, complimentary water and tea and coffee making facilities. Free Wi-Fi is accessible throughout.

The restaurant has a contemporary and homely décor, serving food all day. The continental breakfast is served each morning.

Mercure Southampton Centre Dolphin Hotel (ca 20 min walk from the railway station)
34-35 High Street, Old Town, Southampton, SO14 2HN

Dating back over 500 years, the 4-star Mercure Southampton Centre Dolphin Hotel is the oldest hotel in the city and still has many original features remain including Britain's largest bay windows. It was host to Jane Austin's 18th birthday party.

Mercure Southampton Centre Dolphin Hotel has its own on site car park and offers free Wi-Fi access throughout the hotel.

The award-winning Signature Restaurant sources as much local produce as possible and is open 7 days a week for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Food is also available in the Oak Bar & Coffee Lounge.

All bedrooms at Mercure Southampton Centre Dolphin Hotel have satellite TV, toiletries, ironing facilities and a safe. There is also 24 hour room service.

Southampton Cruise Terminals, West Quay Shopping Centre, and the SeaCity Museum are all within walking distance of the hotel. St Mary's Stadium and Southampton Central Train Station are a 20-minute walk away.

How to find Ordnance Survey

Satnav users

Since our building is new, our address and postcode does not yet appear in many satnav systems. We therefore suggest that you enter the address or postcode of the local Holiday Inn, which is the nearest building to us, as your destination.

At the big roundabout immediately after the M271, take the **second** larger exit for Adanac Drive, not the first small exit for the Holiday Inn as directed by your satnav. Our building will appear straight ahead after a couple of hundred yards.

By road

From London, Birmingham and the North

Follow M3 to junction 13, take the left-hand lane signposted M27 west and then join M27 westbound for approximately four miles.

Exit M27 at junction 3 onto M271 southbound. Leave at junction 1 and take the first exit. At the first roundabout take the second exit, and continue to the next roundabout.

At the second roundabout, take the third exit, signposted for the visitors' car park.

From Bournemouth, Ringwood and the West

Follow M27 eastbound to junction 3. Exit M27 at junction 3 onto M271 southbound. Leave at junction 1 and take the first exit.

At the first roundabout take the second exit, and continue to the next roundabout. At the second roundabout, take the third exit, signposted for the visitors' car park.

From Bristol, Bath and Salisbury

Take A36 from Salisbury. After about 15 miles join M27 eastbound at junction 2.

Exit M27 at junction 3 onto M271 southbound. Leave at junction 1 and take the first exit. At the first roundabout take the second exit, and continue to the next roundabout. At the second roundabout, take the third exit, signposted for the visitors' car park.

From Portsmouth and Brighton

Follow M27 westbound to junction 3. Exit M27 at junction 3 onto M271 southbound. Leave at junction 1 and take the first exit.

At the first roundabout take the second exit, and continue to the next roundabout. At the second roundabout, take the third exit, signposted for the visitors' car park.

By coach

Scheduled coach services connect Southampton with London and major towns. Taxis are normally available and the journey time from the coach station to Ordnance Survey is approximately 15 minutes.

By rail

There are regular services to Southampton Central from London Waterloo, the Midlands, South Wales and the south coast. Please contact National Rail Enquiries for details.

Taxis are available outside both station exits. The journey time to Ordnance Survey is approximately 15 minutes.

Buses to Ordnance Survey stop near the platform 1 exit. The 1 is a direct bus link from the station to Adanac Park and takes approximately 25 minutes, alighting at the bus stop on Adanac Drive.

By air

Southampton Airport

There are regular air services to Southampton, both domestic and European. Taxis are available outside the terminal and the journey time to Ordnance Survey is approximately 25 minutes.

London Heathrow Airport

There are regular Railair services to Southampton using South West Trains® via Woking Station, with connecting coaches to and from the airport. Please contact National Rail Enquiries for details. Coaches run from the airport's Central Coach Station to Southampton.
